Use of prefix un- and dis-

接頭辞「un」 と 「dis」

What is a prefix? 接頭辞とは？

prefix is a word part added to the beginning of a word. It changes the meaning of a word from positive to negative.

unやdisを単語の頭につけることで、単語の意味が肯定から否定の意に変わります。

un + lock = unlock (=not locked)
 un + happy = unhappy (=not happy)
 dis + approve = disapprove (=not approving/approved)

Example:

You forgot to unlock the door. I cannot go inside.

I am unhappy, my dog died.

I disapprove your relationship with him.

(Encourage student to ask questions.)

un + equal = unequal

un + done = done

un + professional = unprofessional

un + usual = unusual

dis + satisfied = dissatisfied

dis + agree = disagree
