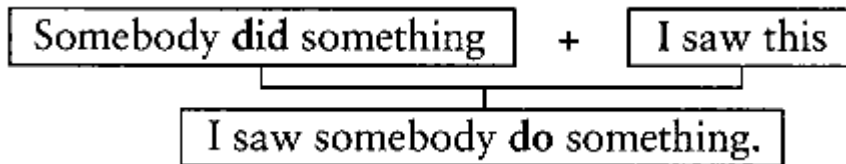
Grammar

Consider the following situation:

Akihiro got into his car and drove away. You saw this. You say:

- I saw Akihiro get into his car and drive away.

**In this structure we use get/drive/do etc. (infinitive without 'to')*



Note that we use the infinitive *without to*:

- We saw them go out. (*not 'to go'*)

But after a *passive* ('they were seen') etc., we use to:

- They were seen to go out.



You saw him drive away.



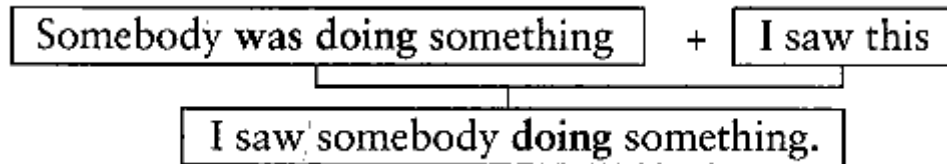

- I saw Ann waiting for a bus.

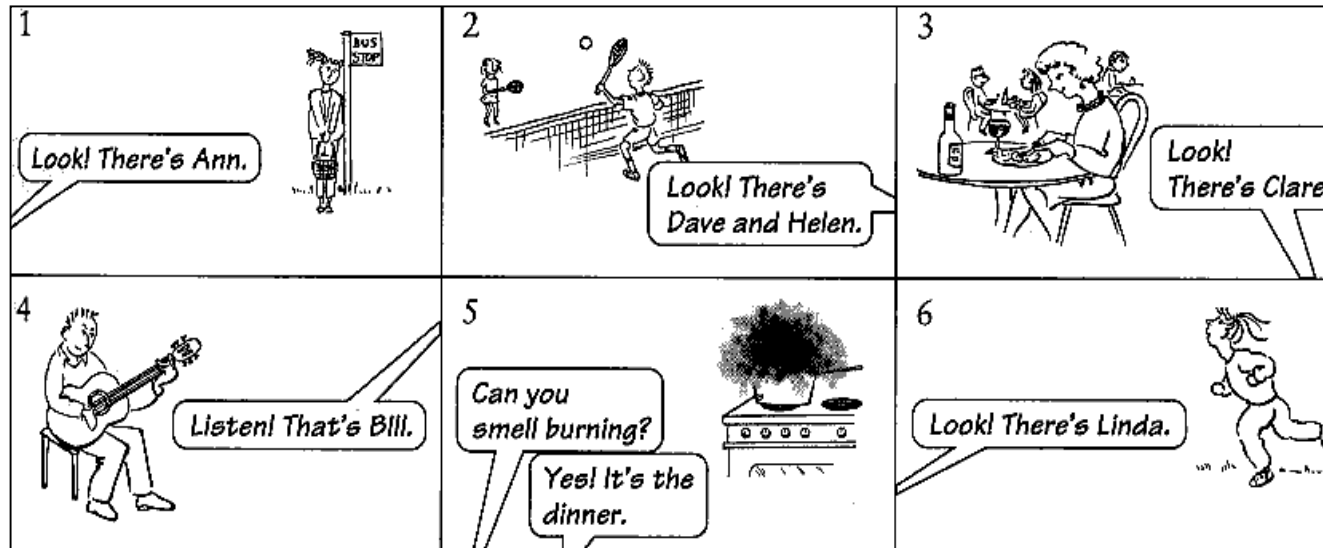
**In this structure we use -ing (waiting):*



You saw John waiting for the taxi.
