significant; influential; essential; crucial; critical

forms: moved; moving to act on; to transfer from one place to another; to change residence

#### •quarter (noun)

form plural: quarters one fourth; neighborhood; coin worth 25 cents; period of three months; district

It celebrates the end of a month of fasting from dawn to sunset.



#### Study this example situation:



Last year Jack and Rose spent their holidays by the sea. It rained a lot but they enjoyed themselves. You can say:

Although it rained a lot, they enjoyed themselves. (= It rained a lot *but* they...)



#### After although we use a *subject + verb*:

- Although it rained a lot, we enjoyed our holiday.
- I didn't get the job although I had all the necessary qualifications.

#### Compare the meaning of although and because:

- we went out although it was raining.
- We didn't go out because it was raining.

#### After in spite of or despite, we use a noun, a pronoun (this/that/what etc.) or -ing:

- In spite of the rain, we enjoyed our holiday.
- I didn't get the job in spite of having all the necessary qualifications.
- She wasn't well, but in spite of this she went to wok.
- In spite of what I said yesterday, I still love you.

#### Despite is the same as in spite of. We say 'in spite of', but despite (without 'of'):

- She wasn't very well, but despite this she went to work. (not 'despite of this')

#### You can say 'in spite of the fact (that)...' and 'despite the fact (that)...':

I didn't get the job { in spite of the fact (that) despite the fact (that) } I had all the necessary qualifications.

#### Compare in spite of and because of:

- We went out in spite of the rain. (or ... despite the rain)
- We didn't go out because of the rain.
