to compile; to increase; to accumulate; to grow

- **check (verb)**

forms: checked; checked; checking
to examine; to investigate; to inspect; to scrutinize

- **enlarge (verb)**

forms: enlarged; enlarged; enlarging
to become bigger; to expand

- **grasp (verb)**

forms: grasped; grasped; grasping
to seize; to grip; to comprehend; to understand; to realize

- **identification (noun)**

form plural: identifications
verification of a person or thing; recognition
