- **leave (verb)**

forms: left; left; leaving

to depart; to exit; to quit; to omit; to let alone

- **patch (noun)**

form plural: patches

area of fabric used to repair a hole; stain; bandage; lot

- **scramble (verb)**

forms: scrambled; scrambled; scrambling

to jumble; to mix together confusedly; to clamber; to climb on all fours
